

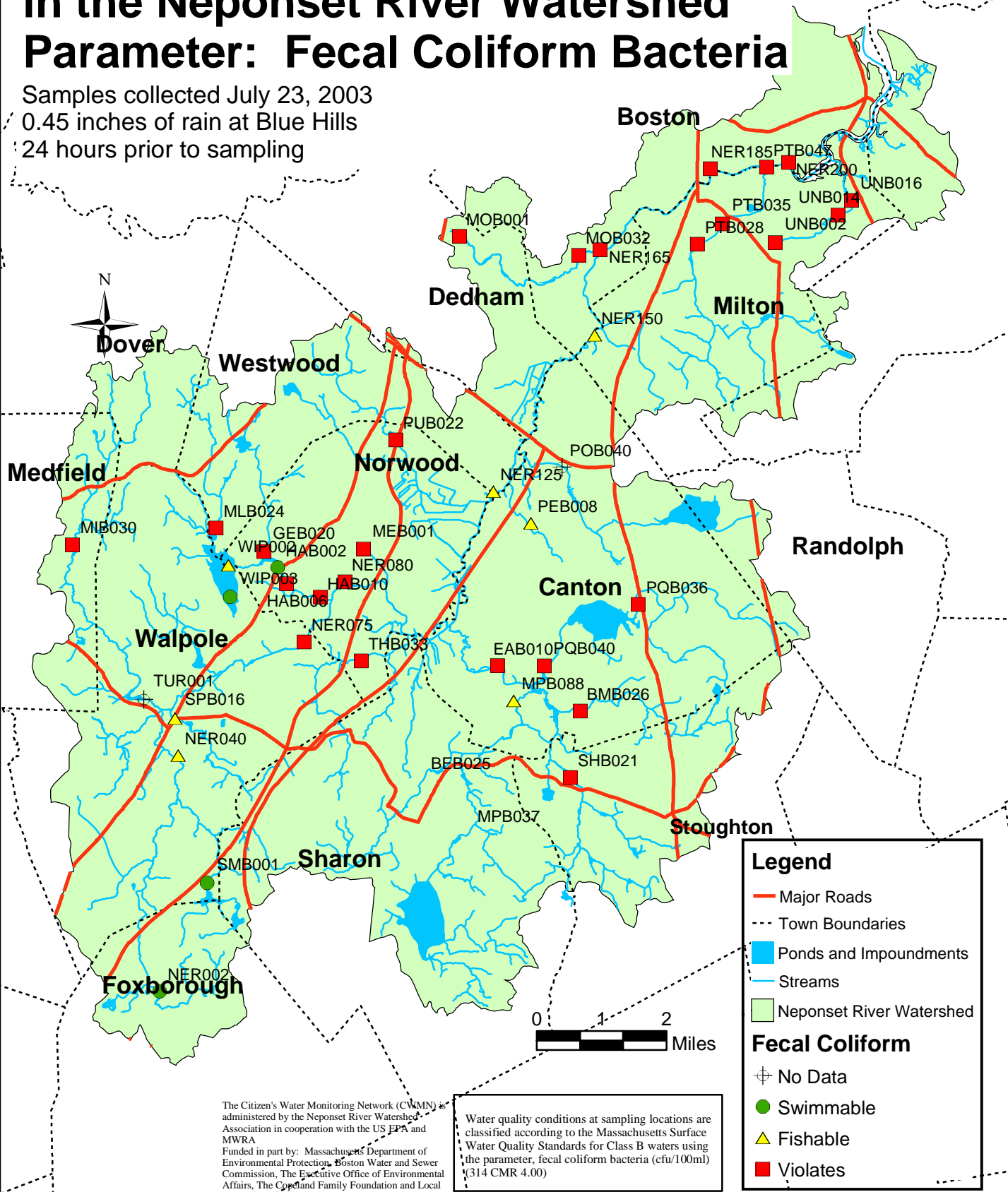
Water Quality Conditions in the Neponset River Watershed

Parameter: Fecal Coliform Bacteria

Samples collected July 23, 2003

0.45 inches of rain at Blue Hills

24 hours prior to sampling



The Citizen's Water Monitoring Network (CWMN) is administered by the Neponset River Watershed Association in cooperation with the US EPA and MWRA. Water quality conditions at sampling locations are classified according to the Massachusetts Surface Water Quality Standards for Class B waters using the parameter, fecal coliform bacteria (cfu/100ml) (314 CMR 4.00)
