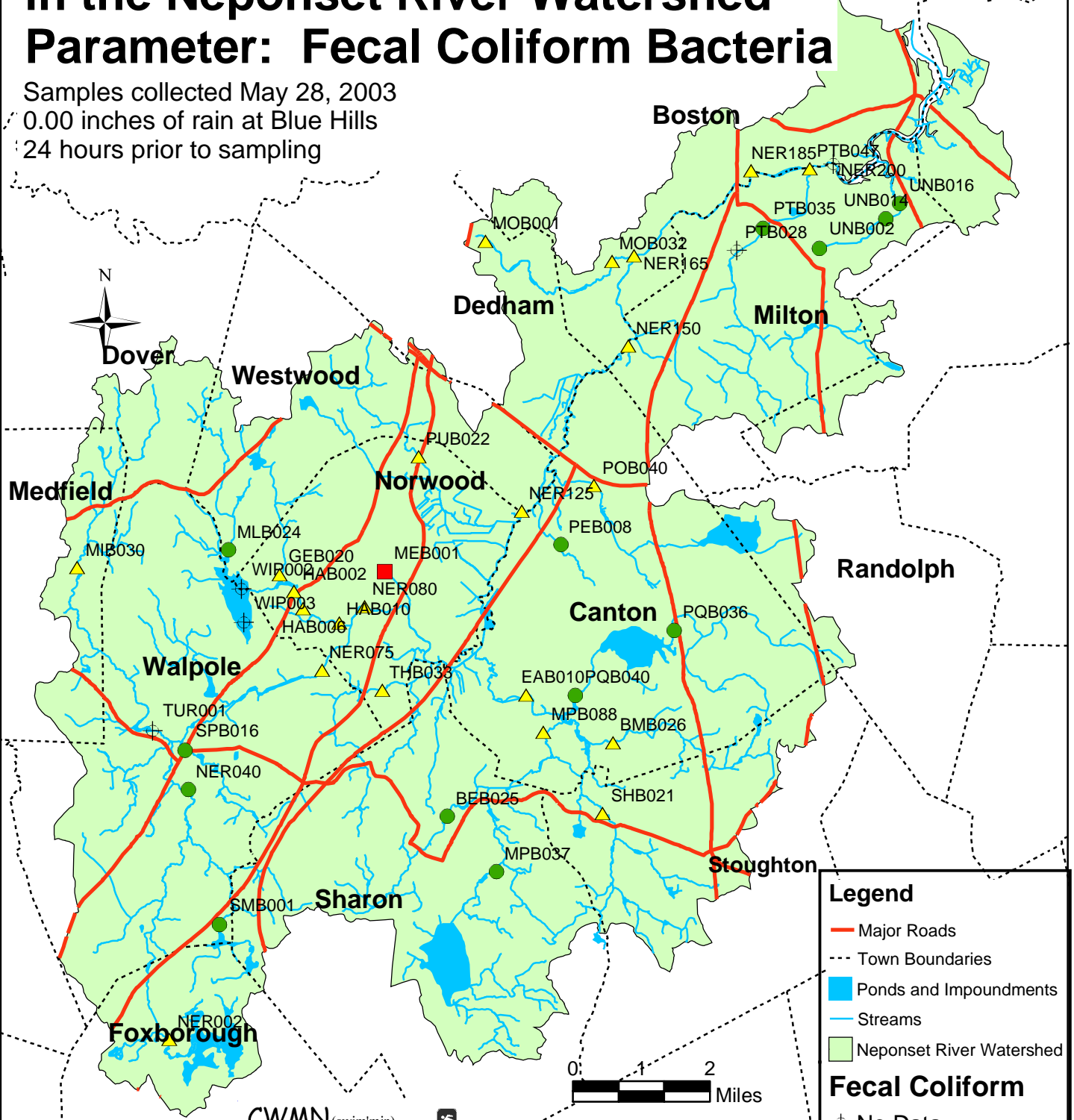


Water Quality Conditions in the Neponset River Watershed Parameter: Fecal Coliform Bacteria

24 hours prior to sampling



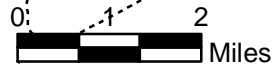
