



Park Serve Day Volunteer Release Form for Minors



For the purposes of DCR's Volunteers in Parks Program, minors are defined as individuals under the age of 18. While minors may serve as volunteers for activities directly organized and supervised by DCR staff or by other organizations, written consent from a parent or guardian is required prior to a minor beginning his/her volunteer duties. Minors who arrive at a volunteer work site with adults who are not their parents or guardians will not be allowed to participate in volunteer activities without the written consent of a parent/guardian.
