WaterSense Labeled Toilet Rebate Program
Conditions and Guidelines

Rebate is for half the cost of a WaterSense Labeled toilet of 1.28 gallons per flush (GPF), **up to \$200**, not including installation or inspection.

Limit of **two toilet rebates** per household. Please allow **4-5 weeks** after application to process a rebate check.

Toilet must be installed by a licensed plumber and inspected by the Sharon plumbing inspector following installation. A copy of your receipt, proof of payment (credit card statement or copy of cleared check), and proof of inspection by the Sharon plumbing inspector must accompany this rebate application.

All toilet rebate applications must be made within **90 days*** of purchase.

Toilet being installed must be WaterSense labeled. See www.epa.gov/watersense for a list of 1.28 GPF models or look for the WaterSense logo at your retailer. Find flush power ratings at: www.map-testing.com.

To maximize savings, consider models that use less than 1.28 GPF, such as dual-flush or pressure assist models. Some models use as little as 0.65 GPF on average.

The applicant must be a residential water customer of record for an active, non-delinquent account. The toilet must be installed at the property where the water is delivered.

The property owner is solely responsible for ensuring proper installation and proper disposal of the old toilet. The old toilet must not be reused.

The Town reserves the right to perform a site visit to verify installation prior to or following issuance of a rebate.

The Town is not responsible for toilet performance or estimated savings, and does not provide any warranties or guarantees, express or implied.

The Town reserves the right to amend and/or discontinue this program without notice.

This offer does not apply to new construction.

*Toilet rebates are subject to availability of funds on a first come, first served basis during each fiscal year (July 1st through June 30th). If a toilet is purchased towards the end of the Town's fiscal year, all paperwork must be submitted to the DPW office within 10 business days of the close of the year (June 30th). The Town reserves the right to amend and/or discontinue this program without notice.
